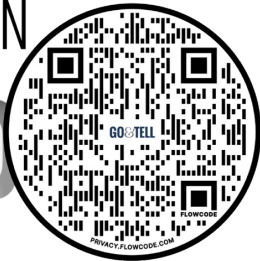

## Session 1

### Shawn Brann

“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my \_\_\_\_\_(1) in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” Acts 1:8

“He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned...After the Lord Jesus had spoken to them, he was taken up into heaven and he sat at the right hand of God. Then the disciples \_\_\_\_\_(2) and \_\_\_\_\_(3) everywhere, and the Lord worked with them and confirmed his word by the signs that accompanied it.” – Mark 16:15-16, 19-20

The Greek word for “Go” is Parul. It means \_\_\_\_\_(4). It gives the idea that we are to transfer ourselves from one place to another but also that the spreading of the Gospel has been transferred to us by Jesus.

The spreading of the Gospel through the centuries is like the passing of a \_\_\_\_\_(5) in a relay race.

## CONTEMPLATE

3. Who shared the gospel to you? Or, who impacted you with the gospel?
4. What excuses do you have for not sharing the gospel?
5. How can I simplify how I share the gospel? Are there any salvation presentation models that stand out to you or would you rather make your own?
6. Did you know that God can use you to see miracles?

## APPLY

- Throughout your day, write down descriptions of who Jesus is and why his message is important to everyone around you. Picture yourself as a spiritual runner, with the Gospel Baton in your hand.
- Research different tools to help you easily breakdown the gospel or write one yourself. Then use it and watch how God uses you to bring his message.
- Write a list of people you know who need to hear the gospel message. Come back to this list. Pray over them and ask God for divine appointments to share his gospel with them.

## Session 2

### Rubin Stebner

“Lord, if it’s you’, Peter replied, “tell me to come to you on the water. ‘Come,’ he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus.” – Matthew 14:28-29

Jesus calls us out of our \_\_\_\_\_(14).

Our call is not to change people but to be obedient and let God work through us.

Start each morning with prayer. “Jesus if you want me to talk to someone today, \_\_\_\_\_(15)!”

### CONTEMPLATE

## APPLY

- Write down the top five things you are afraid of. Do these things keep you from sharing the gospel? If so, ask God to remove all fear and replace it with courage.
  - Write down the things that hinder you or the sins that are entangled around you. Confess them to God. Confess them to others. Be free and run! You were born for such a time as this.

## Session 3 Shawn Brann

“Go into all the \_\_\_\_\_ (19) and \_\_\_\_\_ (20) the gospel to \_\_\_\_\_ (21).” - Mark 16:15

In Matthew 28, Jesus said to “go and make disciples to all nations”. The original Greek word for nations is *ethnos* and means to go to all \_\_\_\_\_ (22).

In Mark 16, Jesus said to “go into all the world and preach the gospel”. The original Greek word for world is *cosmos* and means to go into every \_\_\_\_\_ (23).

Everyone is born an original, but most die a \_\_\_\_\_ (24). Be a \_\_\_\_\_ (25), not an echo.

Preaching does not mean just standing on a \_\_\_\_\_ (26). Preaching comes from the Greek word *kēryssō* and the action of the King’s \_\_\_\_\_ (27).

## CONTEMPLATE

1. We are called to go into the different systems, cosmoses, of our world and share the gospel. What cosmoses are you part of?
2. How does the word “preach” change your view on sharing the gospel and living out your Christian faith?
3. Do you spend enough time in prayer to hear God's voice over all the other voices around you? If not, what will you do about it?
4. Are you a voice or an echo?
5. What are some of the ways Jesus was creative in getting his gospel to the masses or individuals?

## APPLY

- Jesus had private places where he would get away to and pray. Do you have a special prayer location? If not, take this week to consider where that special place could be, and set it as a special place where you and God meet. This could be a private room, a specific chair, a unique spot by a river, etc. Write down where that place is, and ask the Holy Spirit to meet you there.
  - Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal the cosmoses that you may be part of without ever realizing it. Write them down along with a couple of people in each who need Jesus.
  - Ask the Holy Spirit for a creative way to share his gospel with those unbelievers.

## Session 4

Prepare for divine encounters. Just as God is preparing you to share the gospel, so God is preparing others to hear it!

The personal testimony of the Samaritan woman who encountered Jesus in John 4 led to her entire city hearing the Gospel.

**CONTEMPLATE**

1. God wants to give you divine encounters to share the gospel. Are you ready? If not, what do you need to do to be ready?
2. Write out your testimony. Remember to keep it short and possibly use this three-point outline to stay focused: 1. Pre-salvation life 2. Salvation 3. How your life is now since following Christ
3. Sharing the gospel is like sowing seeds. Have you been sowing the gospel message?
4. Where are you the most effective: planting the message, watering what others have planted, or reaping? How can you work on your weaknesses and improve on your strengths?
5. Do you read the Bible daily? Do you memorize verses? If no, determine today to make this a daily habit in your life. Knowing God's Word is paramount in being effective in evangelism.

7. The biggest question of all. This is your moment to run. Will you answer the call?
